History of the Block

Dates as far back as 1898, listed in the Ladies' Art Company Catalog.

Cutting Instructions

Assembled using three fabrics: contrast fabric 1 (red, in our example), contrast fabric 2 (blue floral) and the background fabric (white).

From the background fabric: Sixteen 2.5 x 2.5 inch squares

From Contrast Fabric 1 Five 4.5 x 4.5 inch squares Four 2.5 x 4.5 inch rectangles From Contrast Fabric 2 Four 2.5 x 4.5 inch rectangles.

Assembly Instructions

This block is constructed using two different components, rectangle units and a square in a diamond unit.

To construct rectangle units: Take your two contrast fabric rectangles and sew them together. Press. Make a total of four.






To construct Square in a Diamond Unit:


Take your background fabric and mark a line from corner to corner.






Place these background squares in the corner of your Contrast Fabric 1. Sew on the line.









Trim 1/4 inch from the sewing line.


Press white triangles out.





Repeat process with remaining two corners.

Make a total of four of these units.





Arrange in a nine patch block assembly.

Sew your rows together. Press these seams in alternate directions so you can nest these seams.





Sew your rows together. Your block is complete!
